**The Inn and Conference Center  
University of Maryland, University College  
College Park, Maryland, USA  
March 23 - 26, 1998**

**Location:** The Sixth NASA Goddard Conference on Mass Storage Systems and Technologies will be held in cooperation with the Fifteenth IEEE Symposium on Mass Storage Systems at The Inn and Conference Center/University of Maryland, University College, on March 23-26, 1998. The Conference Center is located on the University of Maryland College Park Campus, on University Boulevard at Adelphi Road, in College Park, MD. All presentations will be held in the Conference Center's Auditorium and the Poster Session and Vendor Expo will be located across the hall in the Founders, Chesapeake and Ft. McHenry rooms.

**Hotel Information:** Limited lodging facilities are available at The Inn and Conference Center. Jorge Scientific Corporation (JSC) has reserved a block of rooms. The room rate, including tax, is \$82.95 for single occupancy and \$98.70 for double occupancy (sleeping room rates include tax). Conference participants may contact the hotel directly by calling (301)985-7303, indicating that you are with the Conference on Mass Storage and Technologies. In order to receive the group discounted rate, reservations must be made by **March 3, 1998**. The Government per diem rate for the Washington Metro area is \$124/night for lodging and \$42/day for meals.

**Transportation:** The Inn and Conference Center is located approximately 15 miles from Washington, DC. It is served by the Baltimore-Washington International (BWI), Washington National, and Dulles International Airports. BWI Airport is located approximately 25-30 minutes from The Inn and Conference Center and is the most convenient airport. The Washington National Airport is approximately 35-45 minutes and the Dulles International Airport is approximately one hour from The Inn and Conference Center.

**Transportation from BWI:/ Washington National/Dulles International Airports:** A&B Shuttle is a service offered by above Airports which provides shuttle service. A reservation must be made in advance at 1-800-480-7363. The cost to College Park from BWI Airport is \$25 per person/one way, from National & Dulles the cost is \$30 per person/one way. Credit cards and cash are accepted.

Super Shuttle is also available from BWI and National Airport; you may be on a van that makes several stops. No reservations are required when you arrive at the airport but you should make a reservation for your return trip. The phone number is 1-800-258-3826.

**Transportation from Washington National:** The taxi cab fare from Washington National Airport to the College Park area is approximately \$40.00. It is also possible to take the subway (Metro) from National Airport to the

College Park Metro Subway or the New Carrollton Metro, and then ataxi to the University of Maryland. This has a benefit of avoiding muchof the downtown traffic if you are traveling light and do not wish to renta car. Note, however, that taxis may be hard to locate after hours.

*Transportation from Dulles International:* The taxi cabfare from Dulles Airport to the College Park area is approximately \$60.00-\$65.00.

**Metro Information:** The University of Maryland can be reached fromthe Metro green line's Greenbelt stop. The University of Maryland ConferenceCenter is approximately two miles from this stop. From the Metro stop thereis a College Park Metro bus, which is free and runs every 20 minutes. Thebus will take you to the student union. From there, the Conference Centeris a ten minute walk.

**Parking:** Free Parking will be provided in the parking garage adjacentto the Conference Center. There is no charge for parking. When you enterthe parking garage, please obtain a parking ticket from the ticket machine.When you are leaving the parking garage turn over your parking ticket tothe attendant and let him know you were attending the "Conference onMass Storage and Technologies." Do not pay for parking.

### **Driving Directions:**

From Baltimore:

I-95 South to Capital Beltway (495) to College Park  
Take US 1 South (Exit 25)  
Proceed approx. 1 mile south on US 1  
Turn right on 193 West (University Blvd.)  
At 3rd traffic light (Adelphi Road) make "U" turn  
Turn right into parking garage

or

Baltimore-Washington Parkway South to Capital Beltway  
Take Beltway West toward College Park  
Take US 1 South (Exit 25)  
Proceed approx. 1 mile south on US 1  
Turn right on 193 West (University Blvd.)  
At 3rd traffic light (Adelphi Road) make "U" turn  
Turn right into parking garage

From Annapolis and Points East:

Route 50 to Capital Beltway (I-95)  
Proceed on I-95 North to College Park  
Take US 1 South (Exit 25)  
Proceed approx. 1 mile south on US 1  
Turn right on 193 West (University Blvd.)  
At 3rd traffic light (Adelphi Road) make "U" turn  
Turn right into parking garage

From Washington, DC:

New Hampshire Avenue (650 North)  
Right at light on 193 East (University Blvd.)

At 6th light, cross Adelphi Road  
Turn right into parking garage

From Montgomery County and Points West:

Capital Beltway (495)  
Take New Hampshire Avenue/Takoma Park (650 South)  
At 2nd light, make a left on Adelphi Road  
At 3rd light, make a left on University Blvd.  
Turn right into parking garage
